8. DEFRA Consultation on Charges at Household Waste Recycling Sites to prevent Fly Tipping

Councillors to note that the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (Defra) have announced plans to save money for households disposing of DIY waste, alongside new grant funding for councils to help prevent fly-tipping. Under the proposals, as part of new measures to prevent fly-tipping, households would not be charged to get rid of waste including plasterboards, brick and bath units.

Defra have launched a consultation, which closes at 11.45pm on 4th July 2022, seeking views on preventing households being charged for the disposal of DIY waste and seeking evidence on the impact of booking systems at household waste recycling centres at:

- Support economic development and regeneration
