**7. Consultation – Renewal of Dog Fouling Public Space Protection Order (PSPO)**

Councillors to note the Hart DC consultation for the renewal of the dog fouling PSPO which has been in place since 2020. A PSPO is an order created by a local authority under the Anti-social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 used to help control behaviours having, or likely to have, a harmful effect on a local community's quality of life. Hart DC is proposing to renew the district wide PSPO and proposed the order will apply to all publicly accessible land within Hart District.

The order will require dog owners (or anyone with a dog in their care) to clear up and dispose of the dogs' faeces. It also enables a person to be served with a 'Fixed Penalty Notice' if the either fail to clear up and dispose of their dogs' faeces (or a dog in their care), or, if they fail to have the appropriate means to clear up after fouling occurs. The order is proposed to last for a period of 3 years.

**8. Consultation - Farnborough Airport Increase in Existing Flights**

Councillors to note the Farnborough Airport consultation on proposed operational changes, see below for main points:

- Amend existing annual flight limit from 50,000 to 70,00 flights per year
- Amend existing annual non-weekday flight limit from 8,900 to 18,900 flights per year
- Increase in operating hours from 8am – 8pm to 7am – 9pm
- Alter restricted aircraft weight category from 50-80 tonnes to 55-80 tonnes and increase annual flights allowed within this category (to accommodate heavier modern aircraft)

The proposed increases in flying activity at Farnborough Airport are not expected to be achieved until 2040. **Appendix A**
